What are the Ministries of Pastoral Care School and Retreat?

Our teaching and healing ministry is conducted through five-day MPC Schools and three-day MPC retreats. Some come to their first school or retreat after encountering one of Leanne Payne's books while others have learned about the ministry through the testimony of a friend. All share a desire to gather with others and experience more of Incarnational Reality, the life we have in Christ:

"I am in my Father, and you in Me, and I in you." —John 14:20

We come seeking something like the story C.S. Lewis tells in *The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe* — as Lucy Pevensie walks through the wardrobe and into the land of Narnia, we come to find our true home in God's presence.

Through the school and the retreat, God ministers healing to the wounds that afflict His Church today, and pastors and Christian leaders find new hope for their labors. We rejoice as Christ accomplishes His purposes in our midst:

"The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because He has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor."

Also, mothers of small children are strongly recommended to postpone leaving little ones for the week of the conference until after they reach two years of age.

Lecturers assume that participants attending this Ministries of Pastoral Care School or Retreat have read the following texts prior to the conference: *The Healing Presence* (*Vivre la présence de Dieu*, in French; *Heilende Gegenwart*, in German) and *Restoring the Christian Soul* (*L'Âme, cette oubliée/Verändernde Gegenwart*) by Leanne Payne. Her earlier works, *Broken Image* (*Das zerbrochene Bild*) and *Crisis in Masculinity* (*Crise de la masculinité / Krise der Männlichkeit*), are also recommended.
